RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe received notification from Vernon Palmer, Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office Roads Engineer, of an increase of \$6,000,000.00 in funding for Western Regional Indian Reservation Roads Programs for the Fiscal Year 2002; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs at the February 2002, Inter-Tribal Council Arizona, Inter-Tribal Working Group meeting encouraged Western Regional tribes to utilize these funds in a most appropriate manner; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that such fundings could be forwarded to the Fort Apache Agency to subsidize roads projection thru the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, such road projects include funding the White Mountain Apache Tribe McNary Consolidated 27 Road Improvements Project to include curb and gutters, 5 feet pedestrian sidewalks and street lights throughout the community of McNary; and
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests receipt of the maximum amount of the \$6,000,000.00 increase for Western Regional roads projects for Fiscal Year 2002 for reservation road projects within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that as an example of the utilization of increased funding, it supports improvements to the McNary Consolidated 27 Road Improvements noted herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman or other duly authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman or other duly authorized representative, to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 21, 2002</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe

September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
