

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century provides significant money for road construction on Indian Reservations; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Region has been designated as the agency responsible for administration of these funds for tribes; and


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office Branch of Roads, has requested a listing of priorities in bridge construction desired on White Mountain Apache Tribal Lands for appropriation of funding; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to provide such a listing to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office to include bridges on the White River, Black River, Slide Creek and Rock Creek for adequate funding of these projects; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby instructs the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office to take immediate action to secure funding for the Design and Construction of tribal bridges on the White River, Black River, Slide Creek and Rock Creek.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman or other duly authorized representative, to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
