

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century provides significant money for road construction on Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has been designated as the agency to administer these funds for the Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Branch of Roads, Western Regional Office, has identified additional monies for construction; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Roads Committee and the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have requested to change to include in the scheduled streets projects within the communities of Cibecue and Cedar Creek additional streets identified in the attached maps; and


WHEREAS, the Tribe acknowledges the need for gratuitous right-of-way necessary to complete these community streets project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the BIA, Western Regional Office to facilitate the request made by the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Tribal Roads Committee to include in its scheduled street projects for Cedar Creek the addition of Bear Paw lane and a section of East DI Road and in Cibecue the addition of East Center Street, North Ivins Lane & R310 and South Elm Dr.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all other priorities remain in effect.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 200 duly adopted by a vote of Seven for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b),(h), (j), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

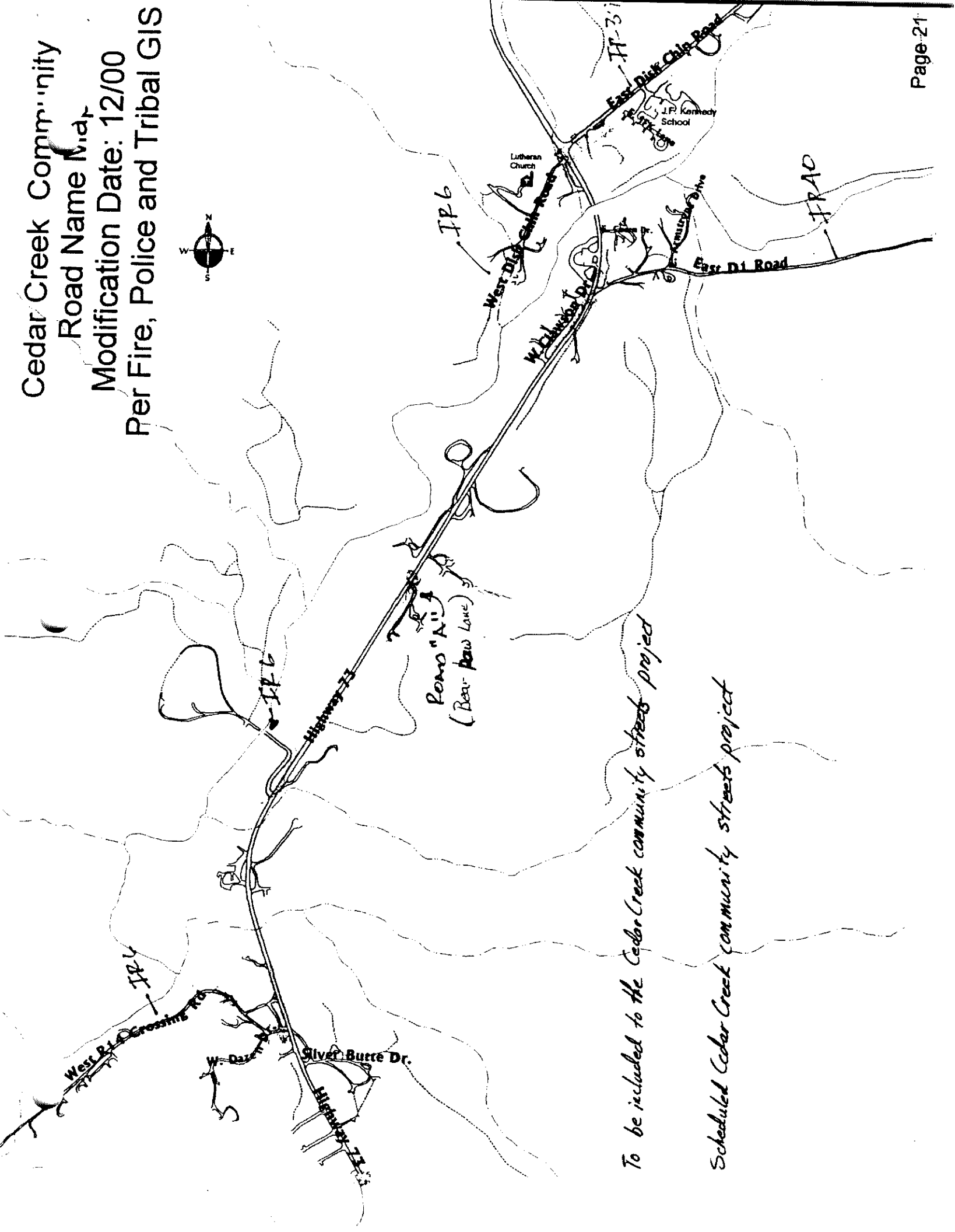
