RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Patsy Nosie has come before the Council and asked for housing assistance; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Nosie has described for the Council the poor condition of her HIP home and has provided photographs showing the unacceptable home conditions; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Ms. Nosie needs assistance from resources available through the Tribal housing programs and related programs to provide Ms. Nosie with a new, safe and suitable dwelling.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Tribal programs coordinate their services to secure funding to construct a new home adequate for Tribal Member Patsy Nosie.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all applicable Tribal programs, on receipt of this resolution, shall need to coordinate such services as are needed to carry out the intent of this resolution on behalf of Tribal Member Patsy Nosie. All applicable Tribal programs are to report back to the Tribal Council regarding the projected completion date of the home within thirty (30) days.

The foregoing resolution was on May 17, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
