

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member Poppy Norma Loring, dob: 07/27/1981, daughter of Sylvester Duke & Lolita (Classay) Loring, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment with the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community; and

WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights was signed by Poppy Norma Loring in the presence of a Notary Public on the 12th day of March, 2002 and are attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on April 23 2002.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment of Poppy Norma Loring and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is relinquished, along with any and all privileges accorded members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges on the White Mountain Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Poppy Norma Loring from the membership roll of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article II, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
