

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Cooperative sponsors four sophomore and junior students to attend a Washington, D.C., Youth Tour annually; and

WHEREAS, these students are selected on the basis of written essays and personal interviews; and

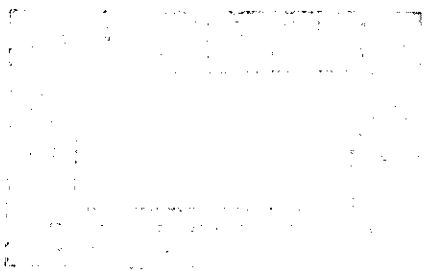
WHEREAS, Stephanie Stover, a sophomore at Alchesay High School, was selected as one of the four finalists to attend the Washington, D.C. Youth Tour on June 13 through June 20, 2002, and her family is requesting financial assistance to cover her additional expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes Stephanie Stover's efforts and hard work and wholeheartedly supports them; and

WHEREAS, monies in the amount of \$500 to Stephanie Stover will be disbursed immediately as she will depart for Washington, D.C. on June 13, 2002.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the disbursement of \$500 to Stephanie Stover so that she may participate in the Washington, D.C. Youth Tour trip June 13 through June 20, 2002.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
