

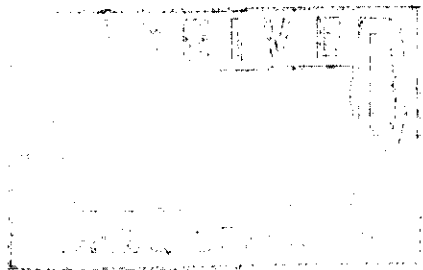
**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has been informed by Jonathan Baylish, Rainbow Community President, of a request for a waiver of fees for use of the Memorial and Exhibit Halls; and

**WHEREAS,** the Rainbow City Community will hold fund raising activities for the community and will need the use of the Memorial and Exhibit Halls.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to waive the standard fees for the Memorial and Exhibit Halls for Jonathan Baylish on behalf of the Rainbow City Community for fund raising activities.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 2002, adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
