(Endorsement of George Cordova for Arizona's Congressional District One)

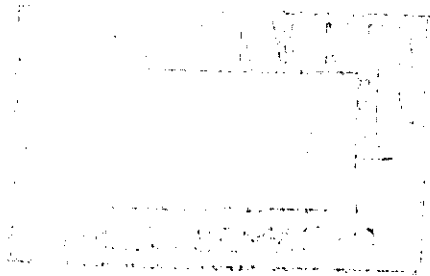
WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is recognized as a tribal government entity with the responsibility and authority to address the concerns of its community in matters and projects that will benefit the White Mountain Apache Tribe community and future development of the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has welcomed and listened to Mr. George Cordova's request for its support in his campaign for election to the New District One seat for the United States House of Representatives; and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe respects Mr. Cordova's contribution to and concern regarding Indian issues.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the candidacy of Mr. George Cordova as candidate for Congress in Arizona's Congressional District One.

The foregoing resolution was on July 23, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of THREE for, ZERO against, and FIVE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
