


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received information from the Fort Apache Agency Superintendent on his plans to hold an appreciation barbecue at Sunrise Lake on August 29, 2002 for the firefighters and crews who bravely battled the Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recognize those brave firefighters and crew members who put their lives on the line and helped battle the historic blaze.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the donation of beef required for the Fort Apache Agency Firefighter celebration from the I.D. Herd and recommends that the Fort Apache Agency Superintendent arrange such donation with Mr. Joe Harvey, Manager for the I.D. Herd.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
