

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received a request from the White Mountain Apache Tribe Prosecution Unit to conduct a survey of juvenile service providers within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in the format attached to this Resolution; and

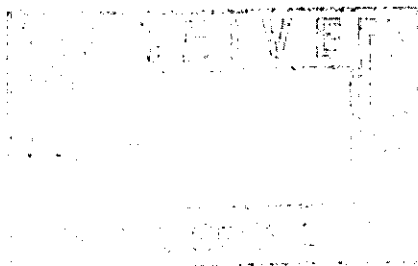
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that this survey is generated through the Navajo County Community Advisory Board in conjunction with the Navajo County Juvenile Justice System as a means to gauge the availability of services for youth who live within the Reservation and who must complete court ordered treatment from Navajo county; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that a survey which will assist Navajo County governmental agencies to become familiar with the services provided on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is in the best interests of those Members who interact therein, provided all personal and sensitive information regarding Tribal members and sensitive departmental information is struck prior to disclosure.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Prosecution Unit's request to distribute the survey attached hereto to White Mountain Apache service providers for juveniles within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Prosecution Unit to ensure that all personal and sensitive information concerning individual Tribal members and all proprietary and sensitive information regarding White Mountain Apache Tribe juvenile service providers shall be struck from the information transmitted to the Navajo County Community Advisory Board.

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
