## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Gwen Numkena, currently resides on her land assignment located at Lot C-3 in the Hondah Homesites Community, and is requesting Tribal Council approval to increase her land assignment to include Lot C-4, for the purpose of improving her homesite; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Numkena has advised the Tribal Council that she wishes to construct a  $storage \ building \ and \ corral \ for \ her \ horse(s), however, her \ current \ land \ assignment$ is too small to accommodate these improvements; and
- WHEREAS, after consideration of this matter, the Tribal Council concludes that Ms. Numkena's request should be granted.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a land assignment to tribal member, Gwen Numkena, for Lot C-4 in the Hondah Homesites Community, for the purpose of expanding her current land assignment to accommodate homesite improvements, pursuant to the following conditions:
  - The premises shall not be re-leased or rented without the written consent of the 1 Tribe in the form of a Tribal Council resolution;
  - 2. Boundaries of the leases premises shall not exceed the original land assignment described herein;
  - The Tribal Council must approve the removal of any trees on the property. 3.
  - Said premises shall NOT be used for residential purposes or any other purpose 4. that would injure reputation or be in violation of law; 5.
  - All improvements on the premises shall be at the Assignee's cost and expense. 6.
  - Assignee shall keep and maintain all improvements on said premises in good order and repair and shall keep the whole thereof in a clean, sanitary, and orderly condition;
  - 7. The Lessee shall not encumber, assign or transfer assignment of the premises without the written consent of the Tribe in the form of a Tribal Council resolution: 8.
  - No commercial business is allowed to take place on the premises, which includes, but is not limited to, auto repair, nurseries, junk yards, or any other wholesale or retail business.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that violation of any of the foregoing conditions shall make this authorization for a land assignment null and void.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman or other designed representative, to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 13, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
