

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed a proposal presented by Dr. Jonathan Krakroff and Chris Gonzales working with the Search for Diabetes in Youth Program, funded by the Centers for Disease Control and supported by the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases to study characteristics of diabetes within the Tribal Community; and

WHEREAS, the proposed study would enroll study participants in a data base to improve techniques for the proper identification of different types of diabetes as found among age, sex, and ethnic group classifications; and

WHEREAS, the study would also help to identify risk factors associated with the onset of diabetes, and also provide comprehensive medical evaluations for the study participants; and

WHEREAS, the identity of each participant will be kept confidential; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that both the Tribal Health Board and the IHS Whiteriver Service Unit staff have reviewed and approved the project and recommend its passage by the Tribal Council because of the benefits it could procure for the Tribal population and others; and

WHEREAS, the study will be done in close partnership with the Tribe and the IHS Service Unit.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the search for diabetes in youth study funded by the Centers for Disease Control and supported by the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases, subject to terms and conditions set forth above.

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
