

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS, tribal member Murray Leslie currently has a residential lease with the White Mountain Apache Tribe for his home site located at Lot A-62 in the Hondah Homesites Community, and is applying for a HUD 184 loan for construction of a new home; and
- WHEREAS, in order to complete his loan application, Mr. Leslie is required to obtain a current Title Status Report on the leased premises from the BIA Title Plant, in addition to obtaining Tribal Council permission to encumber the leasehold premises; and
- WHEREAS, the BIA Title Plant has advised that they are unable to provide a Title Status Report due to an incorrect legal description cited in Mr. Leslie's Residential Lease; and
- WHEREAS, a Lease Modification, attached hereto, has been prepared by the Tribal Legal Department which corrects the legal description in Mr. Leslie's Residential Lease; and
- WHEREAS, after review of this matter, the Tribal Council has agreed to authorize execution of the Lease Modification in the form attached hereto, and further grants permission to Mr. Leslie to encumber the leasehold premises.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Lease Modification, in the form attached hereto, which corrects the legal description in the Residential Lease issued to tribal member Murray Leslie.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to tribal member, Murray Leslie, to encumber his leasehold premises in order to secure financing for construction of a new home through the HUD 184 Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice Chairman or other duly authorized representative, to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on NOVEMBER 27, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
