

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Marvin Brawley, Jr. has come before the Tribal Council to report on the final steps of his grievance and to request reinstatement to his former position following completion of the grievance procedures; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brawley reports that he was suspended from his position as the Bar Manager at Hondah Casino, and then reassigned with a cut in pay; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Brawley reports that the Hondah Grievance Committee, after thoroughly reviewing his case, recommended his reinstatement to his position, with additional training, and the recommendation that he be allowed to transfer to another position when available; and

WHEREAS, discussion with Mr. Brawley, the Tribal Council agrees that additional training is necessary for Mr. Brawley to perform all the responsibilities of the position of the Bar Manager and the Council urges that Mr. Brawley be given this opportunity for training; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council also finds that more training at Hondah would serve the career goals for Tribal members and assure better customer service and regulatory compliance.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms the findings of the Hondah Grievance Committee, and on that basis reinstates Mr. Marvin Brawley, Jr. to his position as bar manager at Hondah Casino, with the understanding that he be given the opportunity for additional training to fulfill all job requirements as Bar Manager.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
