FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been approached by the Youth Services Program to place the White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth Council under the direction of Youth Services; and


WHEREAS, Youth Services is designed to serve the needs of the youth of the White Mountain Apache Tribe through activities and programs, while promoting youth leadership development, higher education, good citizenship, service, and cooperation among youth, tribal organizations, and the surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council acknowledges the White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth Council "as the official Tribal Youth Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with certain powers and authority to represent the Tribe as good will ambassadors, to act in matters that concern the welfare of youth" per Resolution No. 05-91-116; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for consistent and stable structure with adult advisor(s) to provide guidance, direction, and supervision for the continuation of the Tribal Youth Council and the establishment of youth programs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places the White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth Council under the direction of Youth Services.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a),(s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
