

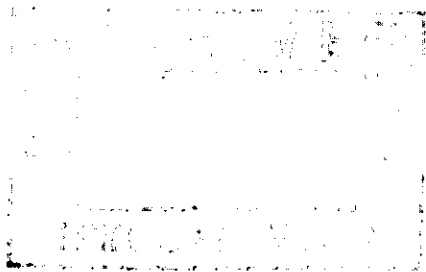
**RESOLUTION OF THE


