

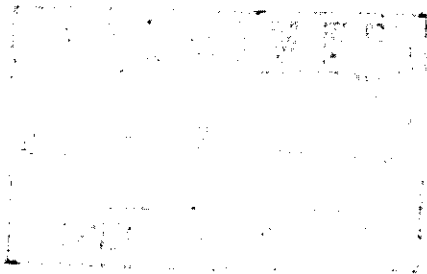
**RESOLUTION OF THE
