

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council on this date has reviewed in detail the audit report for the fiscal year ending April 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the report has, among other items, identified a severe shortage of qualified personnel to manage the Tribe's accounting and financial accounts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council supports the goal of obtaining additional qualified accounting personnel to manage the Tribe's many accounts and financial activities.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the appointment of two additional accounting positions in the Tribal Controller's Department provided that such positions shall be filled by staff who have at least 3 years work experience in accounting or finance and a bachelor's degree in finance or accounting, and such credentials may include, but not shall be required to include, licensure as a certified public accountant certificate.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
