## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS,** Honorable Rick Renzi, Member of Congress, has requested permission to lease office space in the Human Service Building for a term of two years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Legal Department has prepared a lease Addendum for the District Office Lease in conformity with the form lease previously approved by the Tribal Council, a copy of which is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that a two year lease term should be granted to the Office of Honorable Rick Renzi in accordance with the conditions and provisions and legal description set forth in the attached lease addendum, incorporated by reference herein.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a lease for an office space in the Tribal Human Service Building for a term of two years commencing on January 01, 2003, pursuant to the lease form and addendum attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 19, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
