

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council convened this day to conduct an employee grievance hearing for Tribal member Marianna Minjarez in regards to her previous employment with Workforce Investment Act Program/National Emergency Grant; and

**WHEREAS,** as resolution of her grievance, Ms. Minjarez requests that her employment Form E be revised to indicate that her departure was a lay off and she seeks retroactive back pay for two pay periods as limited in Resolution 01-03-13; and

**WHEREAS,** after concluding the grievance hearing the Tribal Council finds in favor of Marianna Minjarez.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Personnel Department to provide Ms. Minjarez a copy of her Form E that shows she was laid off and that Ms. Minjarez should receive pay for 160 hours of labor at her regular hourly rate of pay which was in place at the time of her separation from work.

The foregoing resolution was on March 25, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ONE against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
