RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Peggy Pablo has come before the Tribal Council to clarify her employment status in the Chairman's office; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Pablo explained the financial hardship experienced by her family and the fact that she is unable to file grievance due to lack of a Form E; and
- WHEREAS, Council was informed that Ms. Pablo was offered the switchboard operator's position att he same salary, but she had refused it.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Ms. Pable to take the switchboard operator position.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants back payment to Ms. Pablo for two pay periods.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 16, 2003</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
