

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

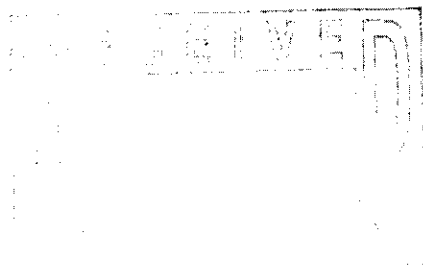
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post Ordinance No. 219, which proposed revisions to update the reference in the Judicial Code to new Tribal-State Gaming Compact; in each district for a minimum of ten days as required by the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Council Secretary advised the Tribal Council that the proposed ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having received no opposition to Ordinance No. 219, concludes that the proposed amendments to update the reference in the Judicial Code to new Tribal-State Gaming Compact should be enacted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 219, to update the reference in the Judicial Code to the new Tribal-State Gaming Compact in the White Mountain Apache Tribe Judicial Code.

The foregoing resolution was on April 21, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
