

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Groundwater-Pesticides Management Plan (GPMP), approved by Tribal Council Resolution No. 11-2001-301 in November of 2001 specifies provisions for monitoring and regulating the use of pesticides on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (Reservation); and

WHEREAS, the Hydrology and Water Resources Program is designated in the GPMP as the program responsible for issuing pesticides use permits on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, three off-reservation private pest-control companies have operated on the Reservation for several years and have established client bases; and

WHEREAS, these same three companies have provided all of the information and met the conditions required by the GPMP in order to qualify for a Tribal Pesticides Use Permit; and

WHEREAS, these companies have paid the required fee for their permits.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the issuance of a one-year Tribal Pesticides Use Permit to each of the following companies: 1) Bug Snuffers Pest and Termite Control, Inc., 2) Aspen Pest and Termite Systems, and 3) High Country Pest and Termite Systems.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the continued monitoring and evaluation of the performance of these companies' activities on the Reservation by the Tribal Pesticides Officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it leaves the evaluation of future permit applications for these same companies to the discretion of the Tribal Pesticides Officer.

The foregoing resolution was on April 3, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (d), (f), (h), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
