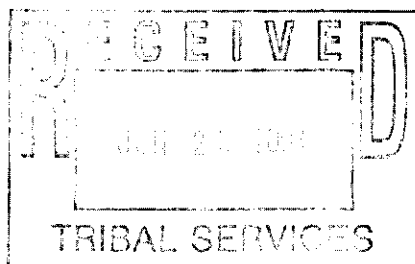
**RESOLUTION OF THE
