## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Carrizo Community President Gillespie Childs, Jr., has come before the Tribal Council this day to inform them of plans for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Rodeo-Chediski Junior Rodeo as part of the activities scheduled for the community of Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Childs stated that the Carrizo Livestock Association stock will be used in the exchange for hay he will provide; and
- WHEREAS, proceeds from the rodeo concession stand will be utilized by the Carrizo community to purchase necessary items for the community; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Childs requests financial assistance to operate the rodeo.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves that \$2,500.00 from the Rodeo-Chediski Donation account be used for the purpose of operating the Rodeo-Chediski Junior Rodeo on behalf of the Carrizo community.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 11, 2003</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
