RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Chairman of the Law and Order Committee, Alvino Hawkins, Sr., advises the Tribal Council that the Tribal Council establish fair representation on the Law and Order Committee by appointing two members to the Law and Order Committee; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hawkins recommends that Vino Burnette and Raymond Endfield, Jr., be appointed to replace Van Hinton and Reno Johnson, Sr., on the Law and Order Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Hawkins' recommendations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Vino Burnette and Raymond Endfield, Jr., to replace Van Hinton and Reno Johnson, Sr., on the Law and Order Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 11, 2003</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against and <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
