

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the community of Cibecue was greatly affected by the Rodeo-Chediski fires of 2002 and various events have been planned to recover from this devastating event; and

**WHEREAS,** the Fourth of July event held in commemoration of the Rodeo-Chediski Complex fire was a success; and

**WHEREAS,** the proceeds received from the event will be used to coordinate other community events and will also be used to assist Cibecue residents with individual assistance; and

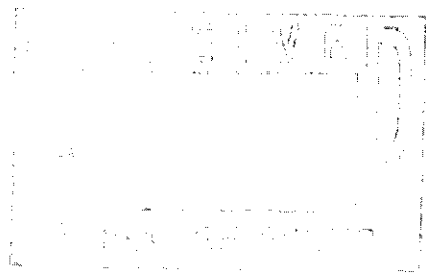
**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council Representatives representing District I request that the Cibecue Fourth of July Festivities be recognized by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council as a tribally sponsored event; and


**WHEREAS,** it is requested that the Cibecue Fourth of July Festivities be sanctioned as an annual event.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes the Cibecue Fourth of July Festivities as a tribally sponsored event.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Cibecue Fourth of July Festivities to be held on an annual basis.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
