RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on this date has heard complaints from Zuni Alekay, Jr. concerning his employment at Hondah Casino and his attempt for pursuing a grievance under the Hondah Casino grievance procedures; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after review of the matter with Mr. Alekay concludes that Mr. Zuni Alekay, Jr. should be reinstated to his position in the kitchen at the Hondah Casino.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Mr. Zuni Alekay, Jr. to his position as a line cook at the Hondah Resort and Casino.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Alekay, and the others who also came to the Council this date to express their concerns, shall be protected from any discipline or retribution by Hondah Casino management for voicing their concerns to the Tribal governing body.

The foregoing resolution was on OCTOBER 15, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
