

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the position of Juvenile Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal court is currently vacant; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.9 of the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council has the responsibility of appointing Tribal Court Judges based upon nominations; and

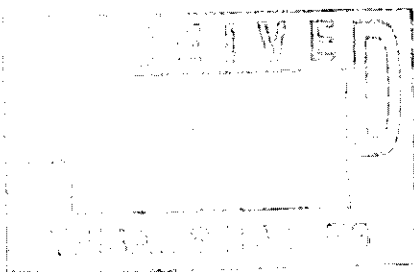
WHEREAS, tribal member Lena Tenjieth has been nominated for the judiciary and meets all the qualifications set forth in the Judicial Code to serve as a Juvenile Judge; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that Ms. Tenjieth has the wisdom and compassion to effectively serve as a Juvenile Judge.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Lena Tenjieth as Juvenile Judge of the Tribal Court for a four-year term.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to Section 2.13 of the Judicial Code, that Lena Tenjieth shall serve the remainder of the four-year term formerly held by Juvenile Judge Georgina Stover-Hastings and ending on October 17, 2003.

The foregoing resolution was on October 16, 2003, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
