

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Ms. Linda Holden came before the Tribal Council on October 15, 2003, to protest her loss of employment with the Tribe's Prosecution Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after reviewing the matter, directed that Ms. Holden be reinstated and allowed to transfer to an equivalent position within the Tribe; and

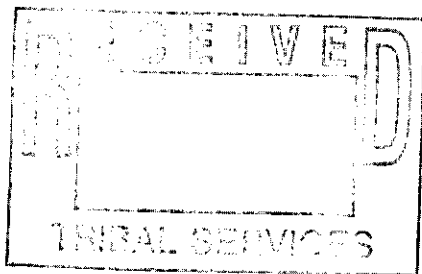
WHEREAS, Ms. Holden reports that she has had trouble finding an appropriate position with equivalent responsibilities and salary for her employment and has requested authorization to be appointed to a new open position within the Prosecution Unit; and


WHEREAS, after discussion with the Tribe's Human Resources Director, the Tribal Council has identified an appropriate position within the Tribal Council office; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Holden has expressed an interest in accepting the position.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Ms. Linda Holden be appointed to the vacant position within the Tribal Council staff, subject to the conditions and rate of pay established for that position.

The foregoing resolution was on NOVEMBER 13, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for, ZERO against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
