FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

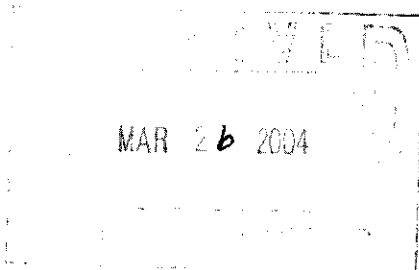
WHEREAS, Tribal member Marty Gatewood has come before the Tribal Council this date to request that he be allowed to purchase twelve (12) Spring Gobbler Turkey tags; and


WHEREAS, the Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division (W&ORD) Director has advised that these tags be bought at \$200.00 each; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the W&ORD Director's recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the purchase of twelve (12) Spring Gobbler Turkey tags at \$200.00 each by Marty Gatewood.

The foregoing resolution was on March 17, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ONE against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
