

**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by the Housing Improvement Programs (HIP) Coordinator, Dan Sorenson, that it is imperative that they authorize the selection of persons for the Fiscal Year 2004 Housing Improvement Program homes and the construction of said homes in compliance with the Housing Improvement Programs Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that authorization be granted for construction of seven (7) new homes for FY 2004 Housing Improvement Programs contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the final selections are as follows: **Ross and Audrey Susan, Pauline Gooday, Rosenda Hudson, Anthony Grant, Lola Machuse, Flavia Caddo and Erwin Burnette**, ALTERNATE: **Marie Aday**; and

**WHEREAS**, these applicants meet the requirements to receive assistance under the Housing Improvement Programs.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the selection of the above seven (7) names for the Housing Improvement Program for the Fiscal Year 2004 as advised by the HIP Coordinator.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 20, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ZERO against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Subj: Current Standing of the Housing Improvement Program

At the present time we are finishing up four homes in the Whiteriver area. One home is for Neva Adley and it is the last home under the FY2000 contract. The other three homes we are finishing are under the FY2002 contract. They are for Gussie Edwards, Hazel Tortice and Arlo Janay. All four of these homes should be finished within 30 days. We have two more homes to start under the FY2002 contract. They are for Waylene Nosie and Mollie Colelay. Both these homes were held up on the start because of land sites and arch findings. We will be digging these footers and starting these homes in the next 30 days.

We have four homes started in Cibecue under the FY2003 contract. They are Dena Lupe, Tom and Violet Caddo, Kendall Thomas, and Nannie Quay. At this time we are doing block stem wall work and floor framing should start in about three weeks. We have two other homes under the FY2003 contract in the Whiteriver area. They are Pearlita Johnson and Allen and Betty Aday. Both these sites are cleared through NEPA and they will begin when we start the Nosie and Colelay homes which will be in about 30 days.


