

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

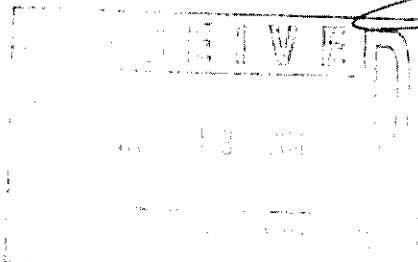
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds that it is necessary that the general public within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation receive timely information about matters of importance to the Tribe and its Members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation, known as KNNB, is the best and most immediate public information media by which the Tribe can distribute information to all persons within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are the two members of the Tribal Council who are likely to have the most relevant and up-to-date information available for public distribution about emergencies, necessary public information and directives of the Tribal Council which are essential for the public to learn and understand.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to utilize, at the permission of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation, the airwaves of KNNB, at times designated through KNNB's Manager, to disseminate public information necessary to inform on, and protect, the health, welfare and safety of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, its members and its resources, enterprises and departments.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 3, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of FOUR for, THREE against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
