

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received a request from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Education Department Director, Ms. Linda Declay, for the Tribe to fund the summer college work-study program; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council recognizes that the college summer work-study program is beneficial to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the youths who participate in the program; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council wishes to continue the tradition of offering its students employment during their summer breaks to become familiar with Tribal operations and to utilize the education they are obtaining at their respective universities; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has designated that it wants to include the summer youth camps in any funding provided to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Education Department; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council recognizes that funding for the programs mentioned herein must be appropriate to the financial standing of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and must be approved by the Tribal Controller as acceptable for funding within the Tribe's budget.

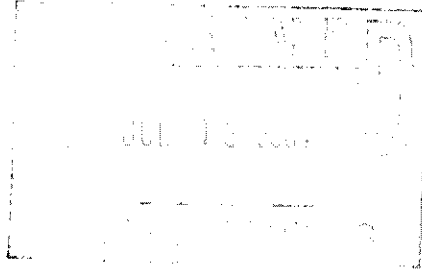
**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Controller to verify to the Tribal Council, through the Tribal Chairman, that funds currently exist within the Tribe's budget to assist in funding with the White Mountain Apache Tribe Education Department college summer work-study program and summer youth camps in the amount of \$250,000.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the provision of funding to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Education Department in an amount up to and not to exceed, \$250,000.00 for funding of the college work-study program and the summer youth camps, provided such funding is compliant with the statements from the Tribal Controller on availability of funds within the Tribal budget.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 24, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by

the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
