RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Tamara Williams came before the Tribal Council this date to share her concerns regarding the harassment she continues to experience from non-tribal member Michael Johnson and Thompson family; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Williams states that although restraining orders have been issued against the offending parties, they continue to violate the orders; and
- **WHEREAS**, she would like assistance immediately as she is concerned for her and her son's safety.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the acting Chief of Police, Mr. Billy Kahn, to follow up with police officers on the continued violation of restraining orders.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Thompson and Johnson families meet with the Law and Order Committee to be advised of possibilities of banishment and to respect court orders.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 14, 2004</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
