

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council received complaints this day from several members of the Tribe concerning their dealings with the automobile dealer Showcase Honda; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has great concern over the acts which Showcase Honda has committed as expressed in some of the concerns made from Tribal members; and

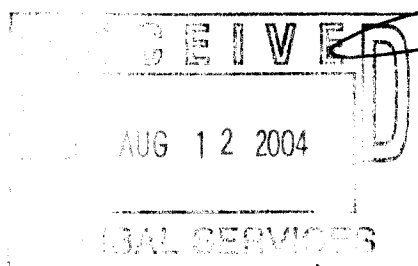
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council licenses and permits Showcase Honda to set up mobile sales office in the parking lot of the Whiteriver Basha's store to service the needs of Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that due to the concerns expressed from tribal members it must now permanently revoke all licenses, permissions and permits issued to Showcase Honda that enable it to conduct sales and solicitations at any location within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby permanently revokes all sales permits, peddlers permits, licenses, permissions and grants of entry to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation given to Showcase Honda and any and all of its affiliated and parent enterprises and corporations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs that the Tribal Legal Department assist the Tribal members who came before the Tribal Council this day in identifying state agencies and local agencies and departments able to assist them in pursuing any recovery they may have for injury and damages they have incurred as a result of actions of Showcase Honda.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
