

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Richard Caddo appeared before the Tribal Council last month with a complaint and allegation that the home he rented in Whiteriver may have allegedly caused lead poisoning in two of his children and elevated levels of lead in other occupants of the home; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council previously authorized the Tribal Chairman to request that the Arizona Department of Health and the Indian Health Services Office of Environmental Health work together to determine the exact cause of the elevated levels of lead in the home which Mr. Caddo and his family occupy; and

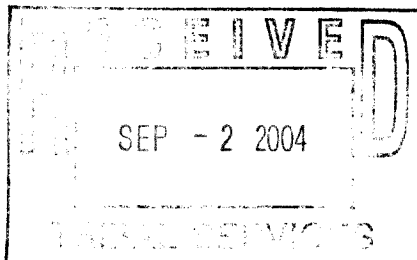
WHEREAS, Mr. Caddo no longer lives in the home which he complains of as the source of high levels of lead in his family; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has heard Mr. Caddo's request that he be reimbursed for the rent he paid to live in the home which he alleges may be contaminated with materials with high levels of lead in them, but the Tribal Council wishes to confirm the source of such lead prior to making any final decision in this regard.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Legal Department to contact the Indian Health Services, Whiteriver Unit, Office of Environmental Health to determine the status of their evaluation and that of the Arizona Department of Health into the allegations of lead poisoning obtained from the home in which Richard Caddo previously resided in Whiteriver.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests that the Legal Department provide notice to the Tribal Council of the status of its review within ten days of the date of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 14, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
