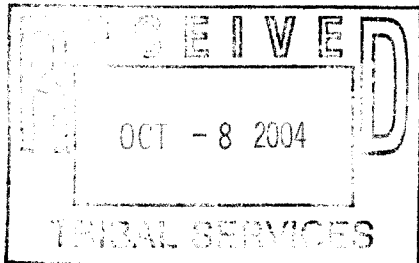
**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**





Meeting opened with prayer from Emily Martine at 9:27 a.m.

1. Eileen Moody – Brought in application and relinquishment form from her mother on a cornfield in Seven Mile. Board approved the request.
2. Rosie Gordon – Wanting the lot in Canyon Day that once belong to her parents, stated that the homeowner Nick Riley that lives nearby won't give up that land and says that it belongs to him. Advised to go to courts and have a probate. Also requested for her name to be put on cornfield application that belong to her late husband David Gordon. Was given application.
3. Earl Loas Sr., - Dispute on Cornfield in Canyon Day Field # 70, between him and his brother Wesley Loas. Board advised for both to attend the meeting next month on June 24, 2004.

9. Lydo Toggie – Requesting for land in upper East Fork for farming. President for Turkey Creek livestock signed off the request. Board approved.
