

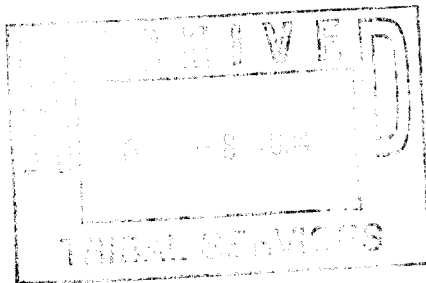
**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**




