

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member Baxter Quesada, dob: 09/18/38, son of Mike and Hazel (Moyah) Quesada, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with the Yavapai-Apache Tribe; and

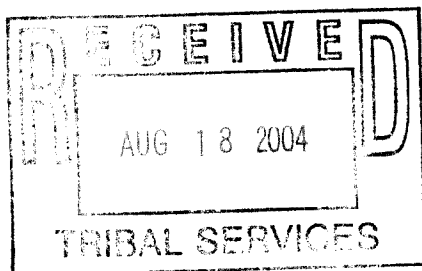
WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights was signed by Baxter Quesada in the presence of a Notary Public on the 13th day of JULY, 2004 and are attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on July 1, 2004.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Baxter Quesada, and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Baxter Quesada from the membership roll of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 6, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of THREE for, ZERO against, and THREE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
