

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council received comment this day from Joyce Bahe that her late husband, Leonard Bahe was required to reimburse the Tribal Education Department for an alleged overpayment made to him in his salary while working as the JOM Coordinator; and

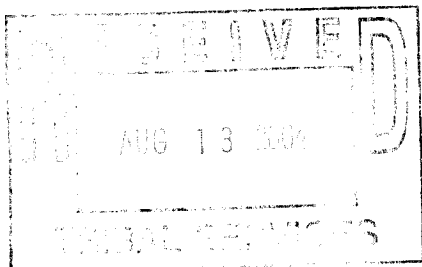
WHEREAS, Ms. Bahe has provided the Tribal Council written proof of her late husband's repayment of the alleged \$5,625.60 owed for hours he was overpaid in salary due to incorrect records of the time keeper for the Tribal Education Department; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned that Mr. Bahe was required to reimburse the Education Department for what appears to be an error of the Timekeeper of such Department, and that this matter must be investigated to determine the cause of such error.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Education Department Director, the Tribal Controller, and the Tribal Attorney to review the claims of Ms. Joyce Bahe as provided this day, along with the letters documenting the alleged overpayment and Mr. Leonard Bahe's repayment, and determine whether there was indeed an overpayment of funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney shall report to the Tribal Council, in one week, the findings of the reviewing parties and a determination whether Mr. Leonard Bahe should have repaid the amounts as alleged overpaid.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 6, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
