RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council received an emergency request this day from Michael Dude and Maybelline Opah, with support from Georgina Cromwell of the Whiteriver Public Health Indian Hospital Social Services, for identification of a home where the couple can live; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council is advised that Michael Dude and Maybelline Opah have a two month old child and are homeless.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Councilman Reno Johnson, Sr., who is also the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Board Chairperson, to assist Michael Dude and Maybelline Opah in locating a home where they can live and raise their young daughter.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>AUGUST 6, 2004</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
