- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it appreciates the dedicated services that Congressman Renzi has offered during his first term and that it acknowledges Mr. Renzi as a strong advocate for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses Mr. Rick Renzi for his re-election to the United States Congress in Arizona's District One.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>AUGUST 26, 2004</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
