

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member Jake Burnette, dob: 09/11/85 son of Wilburson Burnette & Juanita Wilson, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with the Salt River Pima – Maricopa Indian Community; and

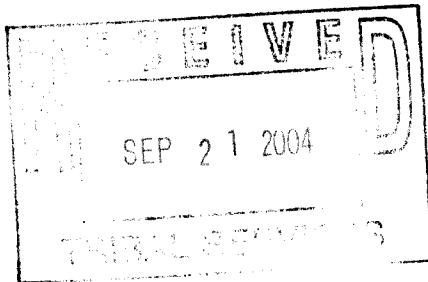
WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights was signed by Jake Burnette in the presence of a Notary Public on the 22nd day of July, 2004 and are attached hereto; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on August 10, 2004.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Jake Burnette, and his Tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Jake Burnette from the membership roll of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 8, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of FOUR for, ZERO against, and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
