

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

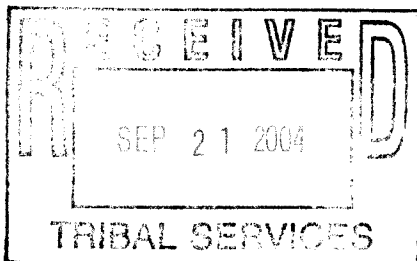
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a request this day from Tribal Member Glenda Hernandez to ask permission for her and her husband to operate a saw repair, welding, oil sales and hay sales business from their home; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hernandez has advised the Tribal Council that she cleared her proposal for a home business through the White Mountain Apache Tribe Housing Authority and received approval of such proposal pending formal approval of the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hernandez has advised the Council that she will ensure the home business does not offend her neighbors and does not cause any pollution (light, noise, resource and other) nor cause injury to any resource of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and that the home business would be conducted only so long as is necessary to enable Ms. Hernandez and her husband to obtain funding essential to establishing their business site across from the Whiteriver Airport.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Ms. Glenda Hernandez's request to operate a saw repair, welding, oil sales and hay sales business from her home, provided such operations do not cause any pollution (light, noise, resource and other) nor cause injury to any resource of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and that the home business would be conducted only so long as is necessary to enable Ms. Hernandez and her husband to obtain funding essential to establishing their business site across from the Whiteriver Airport.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 9, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
