RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has heard from Tribal Member Leanne Endfield about her concerns surrounding her release from employment with the Hon-Dah Resort Conference Center; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes the release of Leanne Endfield from her employment with the Hon-Dah Resort Conference Center is worthy of reconsideration.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Leanne Endfield to her employment with the Hon-Dah Resort Conference Center, in the same position which she occupied prior to her removal.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes back pay of two pay periods.

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 2004, duly adopted by a vote of FOUR for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
