

**Resolution No. 10-2004-243**

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has endorsed activities as set out in the Burned Area Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation (BAER) Plan for the Rodeo-Chediski Fire; and

**WHEREAS**, work begun under that Plan is not yet completed; and

**WHEREAS**, approximately \$140,000.00 in funds supposedly remain with which to complete the Irrigation Channel Protection Project portion of the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Tribal member employees working on that Project were recently told not to report for any additional work; and

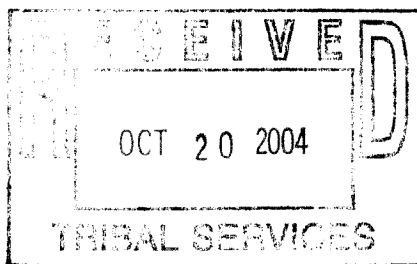
**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council desires that the Project work continue until the Project is completed; and


**WHEREAS**, the Council also prefers that local equipment be utilized for such work as it is available instead of relying on off-Reservation rental contractors for such devices.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that individuals in charge of the BAER Irrigation Channel Protection Project shall continue to work on said Project until it is completed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs that Project directors continue to utilize Tribal members previously working on said project until no work remains and that local equipment is utilized as it is available rather than obtaining such devices from off-Reservation contractors and rental providers.

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 2004, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
