(Approval to reinstate Tribal Investigators)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has this date discussed the need to re-instate their own Tribal Investigators; and

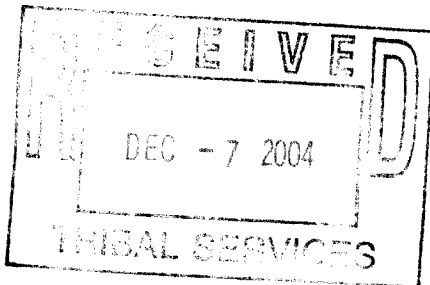
WHEREAS, the tribe has qualified tribal and non-tribal members investigators who have obtained the required certification and training necessary to be investigators; and


WHEREAS, there continues to be an increase in crimes yet there is limited investigators and only through the Bureau of Indian Affairs Law Enforcement.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it reinstates the Tribal Investigators immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby notifies and directs Walter Lamar, Acting Director, BIA Law Enforcement Services and Steve Juneau, Special Agent in Charge, of the above and to assist in this effort in a timely manner.

The foregoing resolution was on November 8, 2004, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (q), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
