## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approval to grant non-member burial on F.A.I.R.)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Stephanie Palmer is requesting Tribal Council permission for her mother, Rhoda Palmer, to be buried in Canyon Day, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, Rhoda Palmer was not a member of the Tribe; however, her children are Tribal Members
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the request by Stephanie Palmer and family members of the late Rhoda Palmer that she be buried in Canyon Day, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 1, 2004</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
