## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Participation in the Title VI Program to Provide Nutrition Services and Non-Medical and Community Based Services for the Elderly and Handicapped)

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has contracted with and wishes to continue to contract with the Administration on Aging, Older American Act, to provide Title VI Nutrition and Non-Medical and Community Based Services for the elderly members of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe contributes funding to the Elderly Program and does not require Tribal elders to make donations and contributions for Nutrition Services and Non-Medical and Community Based Services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the participation of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the Title VI Program to provide Nutrition Services and Non-Medical and Community Based Services for the elderly and handicapped in the planning and service area.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it does hereby waive the donation policies of the Older Americans Act in order to ensure all elders receive nutrition services at no cost to the elders.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents required to execute a contractual agreement for Title VI with the Administration on Aging, Older Americans Act.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JANUARY 6, 2005</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
